THE BRINK INTERNSHIP:

Brink's 15-week Internship seeks to bring underrepresented and diverse voices into the publishing industry. Interns learn the essential ins and outs of the industry and become crucial contributors to the positive social change Brink Literacy Project affects every day.

The program is conducted entirely online so applicants from anywhere in the world can participate as long as they have access to WiFi. Interns typically work 10 hours a week. Every Brink intern receives a small stipend of \$300.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

SPRING INTERNSHIP

- Applications Open: **Aug 1st**
- Application Deadline: **Dec 1st**
- Referrer Deadline: **Dec 15th***
- Cycle Runs: **Jan/Feb – Apr/May**

FALL INTERNSHIP

- Applications Open: **Mar 1st**
- Application Deadline: **July 1st**
- Referrer Deadline: **July 15th***
- Cycle Runs: **Aug/Sept – Nov/Dec**

*Applicants are responsible for letting their referrers know when and how to send in their letters of recommendation. Full details about our procedure are provided in the internship application.
